Nationally homologated cars may participate in the European Rally Trophy rallies when they fit into a national group/class of the organising country, without eligibility to score Trophy points. [National car – classes and group]

The organiser may partially refund entry fees, if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

According to existing regulations in Spain, the insurance policy handled by the Organizers covers the guarantees required by the RFE de A:

Compulsory civil liability to third parties, according to the stipulations of the Spanish law.

Payment up to a maximum of € 15,000,000 per claim for material damages and € 70,000,000 per claim for personal injury in the event of an accident or fire caused by vehicles Participants in the rally and whose drivers have been declared civilly liable.

In case of accident, the Participant or his representative must notify in writing to the Clerk of the Course in the shortest possible time and a maximum of 24 hours. You must explain the circumstances under which the accident occurred. Similarly, you must mention the names and addresses of any witnesses.

Only damage caused by the Organizers and participants Pilots are covered by insurance underwritten by the organization. Damage to the pilots themselves or participating vehicles are not covered by this insurance may occur.

Competitors and registered pilots are free to hire an individual policy for their own convenience, regardless of the responsibilities covered by above.

In case of accident, competitors and drivers excluded from all liability to the Organizer and promoters of the competition and make waive any claim against them.











The service vehicles, even those bearing a special plate issued by the Organizer, may never be considered official participants in the Rally. So, they never will be covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of the owner and / or driver.

Auxiliary and service vehicles (except cars 0) and / or any other vehicle bearing a plaque provided by the Organizer will not be covered by insurance Rally and remain under the sole responsibility of the owner and / or driver.

The vehicle used by pilots for reconnaissance, even if they carry a specific sticker, must be insured by their owners. The Organizer shall not be liable for such vehicles.

Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. It is not allowed to cut the panel.

Art. 9.2 Specific regulations

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance and / or shakedown will penalised according to FIA RRSR Article 20.2.

All reconnaissance cars must be equipped with a speed control checking devise. This devise can be collected according the programme in chronological order (SR Art. 3)

- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences

- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car registration papers

These cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighting.

Art. 12.1 Ceremonial start procedures and order

The ceremonial start is compulsory for all competing cars and will be held on Thursday 09 May at 18:00 in the Pódium Exit.

Before the ceremonial start vehicles will be grouped in the Park Departure Ceremony from 17:00 to 18:00, located in Avda. Rafael Puig Lluvina, Playa de las Americas.

Participants or members of your team appointed by themselves must present vehicles in this park.

Participants must wear homologated fireproof clothing.

Enter with a delay superior to 15 minutes in the Park ceremony entail a cash penalty of € 120,00.

The initial output range will be 30 seconds, and in descending numerical order (the last participant to the first). If necessary this range may vary, not being required to be the same for all participants.

If a vehicle can not take part in the ceremonial start will be allowed to exit at the first stage to your departure time, as long as it has notified to the Stewards during their meeting and has passed the relevant Scrutineering. However, the team must be present wearing his fireproof mono (without car) Departure Ceremony.
